One Bommighter 1 fitted Mark VII A.I., pilot S/L. C.H. Goodman, R/O F/O W.F.E. Thomas, took off West Malling 0030 hours and landed 0150 hours on 8.3.43. The Leanfighter was controlled by Sector (Controller F/T, Webber) and told to orbit Beacon "L" at 12,000 feet, were given "smack" almost immediately south and a contact was obtained at maximum range at 12,000 feet altitude on an aircraft slightly below and to port. The target was jinking violently and was chased for about 5 minutes south west: A visual was then obtained at 350 yards range and was identified at 200 yards as a Do. 217. The Beau opened fire at 150 yards, on the target which was still jinking giving a 3 second burst with cannon and machine gum. A large explosion was seen on the in-beard of the port engine. The Beau drew away slightly to port and then closed in again at 140 m.p.h. at the da lost speed and giving a further 3/4 second burst saw another violent explosion. The e/a practially stalled and the Beaufighter had to climb steeply to avoid a collinion. The pilot then saw a large Tire and explosions on the ground approximately to the south west of the Horsham area at about 0048 hours.

Beanfighter was next ordered to orbit "Boacon"H" and two further contacts were obtained but no visuals, these contacts being lest owing to the violent evasive action being taken by the c/a at minimum range.
